Fold & unfold to make crease

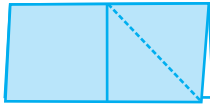


As the name indicates, this fold is made by combining a Valley fold & Mountain fold to form a kind of pleat.

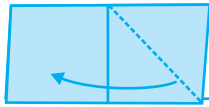
SQUASH FOLD



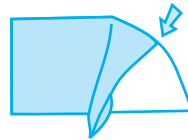
Fold in half and unfold



Fold the top right corner forward & backward over the dotted line to make crease & unfold



Press the top right corner at its upper edge

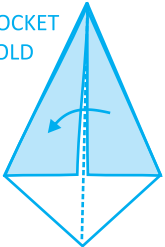


..to open into a triangle & flatten

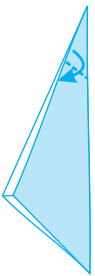


...like this. This is Squash fold.

POCKET FOLD



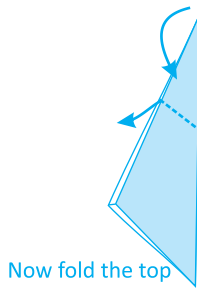
Fold in half from right to left



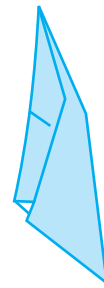
Fold the top corner forward & backward to make a crease

Now fold the top corner at the crease to bring it down between the 2 layers of the paper

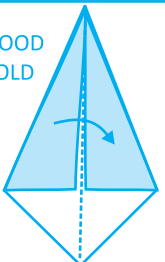


Reversing its middle crease

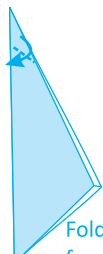


This is Pocket fold.

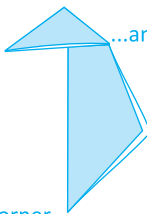
HOOD FOLD

Fold the top corner forward & backward to make a crease

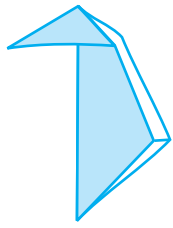
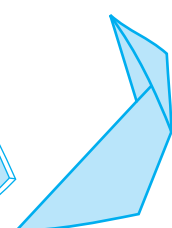


...and unfold
